Applicants must meet the following criteria. No exceptions can be considered.

- Be a female residing in one of the following counties: Brevard, Lake, Osceola, Orange, or Seminole.
- Be a high school senior, undergraduate, or graduate student currently enrolled/accepted in a regionally accredited Florida university or college, either full-time or part-time
- Have a minimum grade point average of 3.0 – as evidenced by the most current unofficial transcript
- Demonstrate interest in pursuing a career related to national security, defense, or a STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics) related field as detailed on the application.
- Demonstrate a financial need
